### SCHEDULE CHANGE FOR CLOSING MASS AT SES

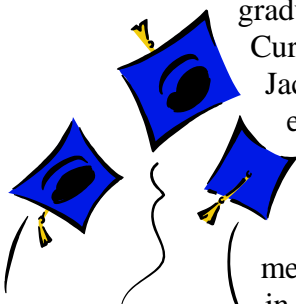
On June 21st the Mass has been rescheduled to 10:30 at SES. Please join us!
